ShapeNZ survey methodology

This survey was undertaken using the national ShapeNZ online research panel. Results are for 2,164 respondents between 5.30pm May 28 and 9am June 3, 2009.

Results are weighted by age, gender, personal income, employment status, ethnicity and party vote 2008. Maximum margin of error on the national sample +/- 2.1%)

ShapeNZ has conducted annual Budget Surveys since 2007.

The ShapeNZ panel has more than 13,000 members, is built from purchased lists and is representative of the population as a whole, compared with the 2006 census. ShapeNZ members register and provide demographic and previous party vote information to ensure results can be accurately weighted to reflect the New Zealand population. SUPER CITIES

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

AUCKLAND'S VIEWS

- More New Zealanders oppose than support the creation of a super city in Auckland (27% support, 31% oppose, 31% neutral, 8% don't know).
- Within the seven council areas affected by the Auckland super city reform, people in six of the seven areas oppose rather than support the reform
- Only within Auckland City Council boundaries do more people support rather than oppose creating a super city in Auckland region (45% for, 25% against, 21% neutral, 9% don't know)
- In council areas, other than Auckland City Council, within the Auckland region more oppose than support the reform
 - Manukau City 45% against, 35% for
 - Waitakere City 59% against, 22% for
 - North Shore City 47% against, 34% for
 - Rodney District 63% against, 17% for
 - Franklin District 46% against, 35% for
 - Papakura District 45% against, 18% for



USE OF THE AUCKLAND MODEL FOR REFORM ELSEWHERE

- 48% of New Zealanders do not want the Auckland super city model used to amalgamate councils into bigger entities in other regions throughout New Zealand, while 22% would support the use of the model elsewhere and 29% don't know.
- In 24 council areas, other than those from within the Auckland region, where respondent numbers equated to 1% or more of the total sample, more than 50% or more of people oppose the use of the Auckland super city model. More oppose than support Auckland-like reforms in all other major centres like Christchurch, Dunedin, Hamilton, Tauranga, and Dunedin.

CONSULTATION

- New Zealanders overwhelmingly believe people have not been adequately consulted regarding the proposed new super city in Auckland (63% say consultation has been inadequate, 13% adequate, 23% don't know)
- A majority in all council areas affected by the reform in the Auckland region feel they have not been adequately consulted. This ranges from 55% in Manukau City to 91% in Papakura District

MAORI REPRESENTATION

- Among New Zealanders overall 48% oppose the Royal Commission's recommendation to safeguard Maori representation on the new Auckland (super city) council by appointing one local iwi Maori representative and electing two others. 35% want to reserve seats, while 15% don't know
- In the council areas affected by the super city, Manukau, Waitakere and Papakura more people support than oppose reserving seats for Maori, while in Auckland City, North Shore City, Rodney and Franklin more oppose than support reserving seats.
- 29% of respondents describing themselves as New Zealand European/ Pakehas support Maori representation (57% oppose), 83% of Maori (5% oppose), 22% of Asian (39% oppose), 59% of Pacific Islanders (12% oppose) and 49% of Indians (51% oppose)
- 22% of National voters support Maori representation (64% oppose), 52% of Labour voters (35% oppose), 30% of non voters at the last election (41% oppose), 64% of Green Party voters (26% oppose), 20% of Act voters (74% oppose), 98% of Maori party voters (2% oppose)

REFORM MANAGEMENT

- 38% of New Zealanders are dissatisfied with the way in which the Government is managing the creation of a super city in the Auckland region: 15% are satisfied (3% of these very satisfied), and 33% are neutral.
- In all the seven council areas in Auckland involved in the reform, more are dissatisfied than satisfied with the reform's management. Dissatisfaction ranges from 38% in Auckland City to more than 50% in the other six areas, with those in Rodney (65%) and Waitakere (62%) and North Shore (60%) most dissatisfied.
- Voters for all political parties, except National and Act, are more are dissatisfied than satisfied with the reform's management.

REFERENDUM

- An overwhelming number of New Zealanders believe the structure of a super city should be subject to a referendum or vote of the people before being implemented. Some 70% of New Zealanders support a local referendum on any super city reform, while 17% do not support this and 12% don't know
- In the area affected by the Auckland super city proposal, 81% of Waitakere, 75% of North Shore City, 72% of Franklin, 62% of Auckland City, and 61% of Manukau City respondents support holding a referendum.
- Voters for all parties support referenda except Act voters (47% for, 51% against). 62% of National voters support referenda, 84% of Labour's, 71% of non voters at the last election, 73% of Green Party voters, 80% of New Zealand First Voters and 73% of Maori Party voters.

RESULTS TABLES

These tables provide the results for all respondents and by region, ethnic group and party vote.

While the maximum margin of error is +/- 2.1% on the national sample, sub-samples will have higher margins of error and should be considered indicative only. Where a council, for example, contributes 13% or about 281 of respondents, the maximum margin of error is +/- 5.8%.
